D'Feet Breast Cancer plans to stomp out breast cancer deaths in Galveston County.

How? Early detection. For five years we have been providing free mammograms in Galveston County.

Due to mammogram screening, rate of death from breast cancer has been reduced from about 50% in the 1960s to 20% today.

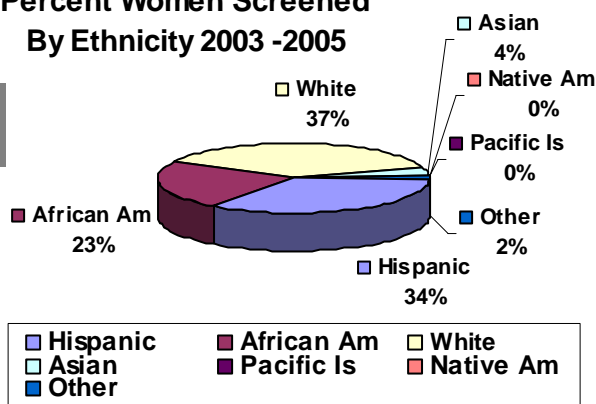
D'Feet provides services to women ages 40 - 50 that are not eligible for Medicare or Medicaid who fall between the cracks.

Galveston County is a very multi-cultural area, with an *above average rate of deaths from breast cancer the highest in Texas.*
